Aims:

Work Process

-regular interfacing with exchange of data

- 1. getting to know our e-pals by e-mailing on twinspace
- 2. getting to know the school each one lives in through a video and e-mailing (interviews-French-English)
- **3.** planning the eco-garden on each side with recycled materials and organic seeds (=cross-curricular activities with biology and art teachers)
- 4. posting on twinspace blog, images of the garden and a record of the activities, on a week basis in turn
- 5. feedback to try and see and account for the diversity of results based on one questionnaire (April-May)
- 6. debate (visioconference) about each school's future/evaluating the eco-garden to foreplan the year after

Expected Results

- 1. Motivation for learning and expanding one's skills through class and field work combined.
- 2. Global ecological and cultural awareness of our environment.
- 3. Physical enhancement of the school environment thanks to gardening activities.
